

THE LONGEST-ESTABLISHED RESTAURANT IN THE BID AREA

The longest-established restaurant in the BID area belongs to Cheyne Walk Club. But so many people don't know it even exists.

Cheyne Walk Club was founded in 1929 as a club for local business owners, managers and professionals to meet, greet and eat and still serves this purpose today. The history of the building is fascinating, built as the mayor's residence and then the home of the Church family of international shoe-making fame. The décor is faintly reminiscent of the Guildhall – Victorian Gothic combined with Northampton stone.

Now in its 86th year, the Club has an ambitious young chairman in the form of Adam Finch, MD of established Northampton business R Finch & Sons Ltd. Adam appointed Impressions Caterers as the in-house catering company, and recently Gary Palmer, formerly of Mr G's café, joined as Head Chef.

Gary's motto is 'Old School Dining for Old School People' with locally sourced ingredients prepared and cooked on the premises a foundation of his style.

'Old School Dining for Old School People' Capable of offering à la carte dining (generally on a Saturday evening), quick lunches and traditional Sunday lunches, Gary is at his best when allowed free rein — he creates dishes from scratch for some of the business groups that meet there, and proudly tweets the outcome.

This summer the Club is making the most of their well-maintained garden, and hold a number of outdoor events and barbeques, including a Hog Roast on 8th August at only £8.95 a head.



Traditional Sunday lunches are served every Sunday (all are welcome, but members get discounts) and lunches are served every week Tues-Fri. The Club is determined to demonstrate that what worked in 1929 – local business owners having a venue where they can meet and support each other – is as relevant today as it ever was.

CICCHETTI GRILL | VINO

Nuovo is Northampton's first cicchetti restaurant. Cicchetti is a Venetian word for small plate and at Nuovo the menu contains lots of Mediterranean inspired small dishes to be eaten in a tapas or mezze style.

Nuovo also offers a range of steaks, including the famous Fiorentina T-Bone, from the charcoal burning forno-grill, daily fresh fish dishes and delicious sharing platters. Homemade ice creams feature in the dessert selection, which also tempts you with churros, limoncello profiteroles and tiramisu.

Situated at the top of Abington Street, (the building that was famously Joe's Diner), Nuovo has a Mediterranean courtyard where you are welcome to dine "al fresco". Inside you can see into the kitchen which boasts the forno-grill especially imported from Tuscany. At the wonderful bar, pre-dinner Aperol and Prosecco are very popular, and the wine list offers a fantastic selection from southern Europe, with many available by the glass. The 'from the Nuovo cellar' selection features some of the finest examples of Spanish, Italian and Portuguese vino.

Worth a gamble

Northamptongent.com, the town's gentleman's portal, has recently reviewed Clary's Restaurant at Aspers.

Find out what they thought below.

"It is quite the experience leaving the

hustle and bustle of the casino ground floor into such a refined environment as Clary's.

The menu is devised of a combination of simple, modern classics. For starters, the team opted for 'Seared Scallops on Pea Puree with honey glazed bacon & mint oil' (£9.25) and

'King Prawns with Chorizo Sausages sautéed in chilli, lime & coriander butter' (£6.50). Getting scallops right is a fine art and there is no worse sin than an overcooked scallop. This was not the case at Clary's, as the scallops were seared perfectly, adding just enough brown to the outside. The king prawns and chorizo were a triumph; spicy without being overpowering. Clary's meat is matured for 24 days before being seasoned. Our steaks were an utter triumph. Cooked to perfection. The team threw caution to the wind and indulged in dessert: A Trio of Luxury Mövenpick Ice Cream (£5.95) and a White Chocolate Crème Brulee (£5.25). The ice creams were rich and creamy.

Overall, the meal was delicious — with the steaks truly standing out as something special — and we feel more than confident recommending it to you fine gents. Also, the casino runs a steak night every Tuesday where visitors can have a chargrilled steak, side and free £5 bet for £11. Our suggestion would be to give Clary's a try then and take advantage of the offer."

Proprietors Daniel and Rachael Sutch have owned the restaurant since 2009, running it as an independent business within the Rennie Mackintosh House and Galleries Northampton. Their aim has been to continue to strive for the best in home cooked fresh food — as well as supplying the most famous afternoon teas in the town.

Served as two courses, on three-tier cake stands, afternoon tea might include dainty sandwiches, coronation chicken filo cups, savoury scones and individual quiches, followed by tea scones and a selection of homemade cakes and pastries. With unlimited tea and coffee it's only £16.95 per person — Prosecco and Pimms are available for a small supplement. Cocktails can be found in all corners of Northampton town centre — you can even have a go at rustling them up yourself in an exclusive masterclass. Meanwhile, if beer's more your scene there's a great array of traditional pubs to choose from.

TOP QUALITY BURGERS on the menu as Bridge Street venue switches focus to food.

The battle for the title of Northampton's best burger is hotting up, with a popular Bridge Street bar now turning its attention to top quality fast food.

The Department of Meat & Social Affairs (previously known as the Department of Liquor) has re-launched following a re-fit which has seen a new kitchen installed and a dedicated team of chefs working on a menu inspired by the American burger scene. High quality burgers are on offer alongside fried chicken, messy ribs, milkshakes, homemade ice cream and a selection of craft beers.

General Manager Tino Pezzillo said: "We're putting the emphasis on fresh, local ingredients and will only be using premium cuts of meat to make our burgers, all of which are handmade and pressed in our kitchens. We're taking the humble burger to a whole new level."

Set across two floors, the interior blends the raw, pared-down character of a listed building with layers of bespoke furniture, artwork and striking lighting, as well as constantly evolving art exhibitions adorning the walls.

Diners can work up an appetite with a game of ping-pong while there are also regular live music sessions, giving local artists a platform to showcase their work.

Mr Pezzillo added: "It's all about raising the bar. Some of the places you see are a world apart from what we have previously had in Northampton and we want to bring some of that calibre of cooking to our home town. The venue has 100 covers over 2 floors and we also offer a take out option.

"We will be recruiting locally and we want to open people's eyes and give them the chance to experience something new.

Northampton is a town very much on the up and we want to play our part in helping to improve the town centre even further."

The venue is now situated over three





We are careful to create food that is as healthy, allergen free and lifestyle sensitive as possible – like our gluten free gnocchi or courgette spaghetti. That being said, we are more than happy to add a little naughtiness to suit your mood – perhaps a streaky bacon weave?

We have a small yet overflowing garden on the premises that supplies us with very fresh additions that we add to our plates, such as parsnip crisps. Often on our way into the café we walk through the market to see if there is anything that catches our eye. This is usually colour based and we have to say that the beetroots are great — especially in a delicious beetroot soup.

We always use the leaves and stalks from the beetroot preparation for our own staff meal. Simply tossed about with some lemon juice, a squirt of olive oil and a light seasoning.


