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### Keeping Northampton town centre clean and tidy

#### BID Hosts

Your BID Hosts, Kimberley and Matthew, visit businesses throughout the BID area on a regular basis to keep you informed of opportunities and projects so you can get involved. They assist shoppers and visitors to the town as well as report.



#### Improving the look of our town centre

Vacant premises are a priority for the BID's clean and tidy initiatives. The windows of vacant premises in principal thoroughfares will be cleaned on a quarterly basis and window vinyls will be installed to improve the look of our streets.

#### Hot spot cleaninc

Kimberley and Matthew have identified a number of areas which would benefit from a more intensive street clean.

The Hosts report issues regularly to the Borough Council, reporting over 261 incidents in January, and the BID will be working closely with partners to



fund additional cleaning in key locations, over and above that carried out by statutory authorities.

To support the enhanced cleaning initiatives and encourage those using the town centre to do their bit, new and refurbished litter bins will be installed in a range of locations, with the BID working in partnership with the Borough Council on their installation.

Our new Discover Northampton series of events promises to capture the imaginations of a wide range of people, with something for everyone, with these events timed to take place during the busy spring and summer months.

#### Northampton Music Festiva



Taking place on the weekend of 20th and 21st June, performances will take place in venues across the town with the Market Square once again playing host to the main stage. The BID will be working closely with the organisers to encourage entertainment across the town.

#### Discover Northampton Easter Entertainment Event

Northampton BID will be staging a bonanza of pop up performance and entertainment taking place in locations throughout the town centre on Saturday 4th April.
